



- I. Cut out the flower petals.
- 2. Decide with your child what your child is working for. Example: extra tv time, a game with mom and/or dad, a special story, a candy bar, etc. Write it down.
- 3. Write down the 6 things that your child needs to finish with your child.
- 4. Every time a task is finished a flower petal is put on the flower.
- 5. When all 6 tasks are done the child gets what he/she has been working for.
- 6. Give lots of praise for each completed petal.
- 7. NEVER take an earned petal away. Once a petal is earned, you don't take one away.
- 8. If your child can't earn all 6 petals in the specified period of time, then you have to make the things the child has to do easier. You want the child to get the reward for completing the work.
